1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank for Bangladesh Road Safety Project (BRSP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the above mentioned consulting services.

2. The Consulting Services ("the Services") include the following:

A Highway Police Training Centre will be constructed under the project at Shibchar. The consultant will prepare detail design, estimate etc of the center and will supervise construction works. 3. Expected date for commencement of the services is January 2025 and the tentative duration of the entire assignment is about **36 (Thirty Six)** months.

4. The EOI short listing criteria are:

- Age of firm: Applicants are requested to submit detail of registration, tax identification etc. Should be at least five years old.
- Experience: Experience of design and supervision of training centers or similar building campus, which construction cost was more than BDT 35 Crore in last five years.
- Key-expert: Qualification of key-expert. Long-term commitment of experts with the firm is preferred.
- Establishment of firm: own office, permanent staff and experts, logistics etc

Applicants are requested to submit supporting documents in support of the above-mentioned criteria.


